Guidelines for Photo Submissions

STANDARD PHOTO SPECS

Prospective contributors should study recent issues of the magazine to determine photographic style.

Do not crop images too closely. This makes it difficult to bleed the image if necessary.

Preference is given to color slides over prints. Prints should be 5x7 or larger B&W or color glossy—no negatives, please.

Name and address of contributor should be attached to each submission or slide, and the delivery should be accompanied by a memo covering the details of the submission. Return method should be specified if other than Certified Mail.

Includes pics sent to us via email, disk or FTP

Digital Cameras

It is important to note that not all digital cameras are capable of taking photos at the resolution we need. The camera should have a resolution capacity of 3.1+ megapixels and each photo must be saved at the highest setting available. Where possible, use a tripod.

Resolution

Must be at least 300 dpi (dots per inch) resolution. (If not 300 dpi, then the size of the image must be large enough that it allows us to convert the image to 300 dpi at the final output size without loss of resolution – For example: An image that is 72 dpi and 22" by 15" will convert to an output image that is 300 dpi and about 5" by 3.5").

Image Size

6 x 8.75 inches for standard (half-page or less) photos, 8.75 x 11.125 inches for full page, and 11.125 x 17.25 inches for spreads.

Must not be any smaller in size than the final size it is to be printed at. (For Example: A pic received at 2" by 1" will not work if the final output size is to be any larger, such as 5" by 4")

File Format

Must be sent in either TIFF, EPS, or JPEG file format. (If JPEG, please avoid use of high compression as this degrades the quality of the photo).

NOTE: We CANNOT accept Microsoft Word documents with pics embedded in them. Word documents are not picture files.

We cannot accept these formats: GIF, PCX, PDF, PNG, PIXAR, RAW, SCITEX, EXE.

Please include a labeled contact sheet or an additional folder containing 72 dpi thumbnails of your photos.
